City Manager Campbell discussed the request from Blevins Building Supply to purchase a small tract of city property behind their building on Main Street. Councilman Hamden motioned that the city manager proceed with the sale of the property. Following a second, the motion was unanimously approved.

Following a review of a proposed road closure for a portion of

the old Railroad Avenue, Councilman Wilson motioned to proceed with a public hearing on March 26, 2001 at 7:30 pm or as soon thereafter as the hearing can be held. Councilman McCarter seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.


