ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The City of Galax (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND PUMP STATION GENERATORS

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received via email at eanderson@chasolutions.com OR in person by Doug Williams at the City's Administrative Office located at 111 E. Grayson St, Galax, VA 24333, until June 2nd, 2026 at 2:00pm local time. At that time the Bids will be open and read publicly. It is the responsibility of the bidder to ensure that emailed documents have been received. Submission of any file larger than 9 MB should be sent via online cloud storage location link. An optional virtual pre-bid conference will be held on May 27th, 2026 between 10am and 12 noon.

The Project includes the following Work:

1. Diesel Generators at the following locations
 - a. Water Treatment Plant – 750KW 480/277V
 - b. City View Pump Station – 250KW 480/277V
 - c. East Galax Pump Station – 250 KW 480/277V
2. Automatic Transfer Switches for each generator, including delivery to respective site.
3. Concrete slab to support each generator, associated walkway and stairs and placement of each generator on the associated slab.
4. Electrical installation of equipment and integration into the existing water system will be by a separate installation contractor.
5. Once installed by the others, startup and testing of the generator and ATS system.
